## The gift that keeps on giving



Modern Art Distillery has been shortlisted for the prestigious 2024 Gift of the Year Award. We're among 11 companies who have been selected for the Contemporary Gift category - "funky, design-led gifts with a quirky modern feel".

Judging to select the finalists will take place from February 4-7 at the Gift Show in Birmingham to be followed by an awards ceremony in London in May. Among those involved is Sara Davies from BBC's *Dragon's Den* series.

The Gift of the Year awards are highly respected industry accolades, aimed at recognising the best new products, talent and inspiration in the gift industry each year, and are judged by over 100 industry professionals who are all looking for the best new products to market.

**Artist update: Yasmin Davidson**





Yasmin Davidson (left) will be exhibiting at Taigh Chearsabhagh Arts Centre on her home island of North Uist from February 3 - April 26.

Her show is called *Dùthchas: Through the Artist's Lens*. The project is based on the film documentary *Dùthchas* - the word Dùthchas roughly means 'home and place' in Scottish Gaelic.

Archived films from 1960s and 1970s Berneray were carefully restored for the documentary, produced by Andy Mackinnon who also spoke to locals about their childhood, their perceptions of home and what it means to them.

Says Yasmin: “As an artist living on Berneray, I have been inspired to create a body of work reflecting my connection to the island. Watching *Dùthchas* challenged my perception of home and what it means to have a deep connection to a place. I decided to create a series of stills from the 8mm films.

“I wanted to capture the film's quality and light. In my works, I try to show light behind the image and the movement the film often displays. The paintings are colourful; my colour palette has injected a new life into the stills and has brought the images back into the 20th century.



“Watching *Dùthchas* is a magical experience. The film transports you back to a time when life was simple, people looked out for each other, and everyone was connected on a personal level. It reminds you to detach from modern technology and tune yourself with your natural surroundings. Home, to me, is a grounding feeling, a deep-rooted connection. *Dùthchas* is a perfect reminder of that feeling.”
