



Lyme rocks with new M.A.D label!

We're delighted to introduce the latest artist to join the Modern Art Distillery fold - Hugh Dunford Wood, from Dorset, who has devised a stunning linoprint of Lyme Regis for our M.A.D bottle labels - called *The Spirit of Lyme Regis*.



Hugh's design recreates The Cobb, made famous the world over for its inclusion in Jane Austen's book of 1818, *Persuasion*, and later in John Fowles's *The French Lieutenant's Woman*, made into a blockbuster movie starring Meryl Streep.

The eye-catching artwork appears on our Blueberry & Bergamot Gin, Strawberry & Honey Spiced Rum and London Dry Gin bottle labels.

It's also available on our mini bottles of Watermelon & Thyme Vodka.

And you can buy Hugh's beautiful artwork - a limited edition, individually signed, numbered and hand-finished linoprint of *The Spirit of Lyme Regis* is available from our Art Shop.

Hugh is a multi-talented artist who as well as making linoprints, also paints landscapes and portraits, designs crockery, jewellery, furnishing fabrics and wallpaper, and shares his skills through running workshops.

His wife Candida is leading an initiative to establish a community food hub called Nourish in their home town of Bridport, and recently organised a fund-raising dinner - which saw the launch of Hugh's label artwork on our London Dry Gin bottle, with a special cocktail produced by the couple's son Jesse.



Classic gin sour

Hugh's son Jesse (above) is a well known London chef and restauranteur - he owns Parlour in Kensal Green and Six Portland Road in Holland Park.

His sommelier Lorenzo created an original cocktail based on local apple juice and M.A.D's London Dry Gin - see the recipe.

Make your own

The recipe is a classic sour on the rocks - each serving has:

- 25ml Elderflower syrup
- 50ml of M.A.D London Dry Gin
- 15ml lemon Juice
- 50ml of freshly pressed apple juice

Garnish with an orange slice and lemon verbena.

Alice Bulmer, the Devon-based artist behind the beautiful botanical label *Hibiscus Kiss*, featured on our [Watermelon & Thyme Vodka](#), has produced a new series of work based around underwater figures.

Each work explores a different aspect of a woman's emotions and the feelings they become free of or escape from while in this underwater world. Says Alice: "There's a weightlessness that is physically achieved and allows for the emotions to not hang so heavy on us."



Her drawing *This Woman's Work*, representing the daily mental load women become entangled with, has recently been on display at [The Gallery at Green and Stone](#), Chelsea.

"The fabric represents the mass of otherwise heavy load that takes over our lives and we carry round with us. Once underwater we are free from what ties us down," says Alice.

It's been a busy time for Chris Pompa whose *Secret Garden* artwork for The Secret Garden Cafe in Bute Park, Cardiff, is now on display. The park is the green heart of the city centre, with an extensive arboretum, and Chris's colourful design hangs alongside two other artists' work in the walled garden.

Says Chris: "It's somewhere I walk nearly every day, so it's a blessing to have my work as part of the park's landscape."

In another project, Chris's artwork for The Carers Trust, in conjunction with the Short Breaks Scheme, was launched in the Senedd in Cardiff in early February.

Chris, whose abstract mosaic *Simpatico* appears on M.A.D's [Blueberry & Bergamot Gin](#), comments: "It was a privilege to be involved in the scheme, which provides funds for respite and breaks for carers, and to draw attention to the amazing selfless work that they do."



Chris's piece was originally unveiled last November by Princess Anne.

Then, on February 4, it was presented to the Welsh Senedd's Minister for Children & Social Care, Dawn Bowden MS, by the Chairman of Carers Trust Wales, Mark Llewellyn.
